

**QUESTION NO 7**

**By Councillor Henderson to be answered by the Convener of the Education, Children and Families Committee at a meeting of the Council on 11 March 2010**

**Question**

At the Council meeting of 17 December 2009 at which the decisions were taken to close Burdiehouse, Drumbrae, Fort and Royston Primary Schools, the Administration moved an amendment which incorporated the following clause, relating to each closure:

“An additional supplement would be made to the school budget at (receiving) Primary for up to two years after closure to facilitate the implementation of support measures as might be deemed beneficial by the Head Teacher in consultation with the Children and Families Neighbourhood Manager.”

Could you please advise how much the “additional supplement” to each school’s budget will be and what progress has been made in quantifying the “support measures” referred to above?
