For background :

Edinburgh Rugby took over the ownership of the Edinburgh professional rugby team from the Scottish Rugby Union in July of 2006, the first arrangement of its kind in Scottish pro rugby. The team, which plays in the Magners League (a league comprising teams from Scotland, Wales and Ireland) and the European Cup competitions (comprising teams from Scotland, Ireland, Wales, England, France and Romania), currently plays its matches at Murrayfield Stadium in Edinburgh and can boast 16 Scottish international players.
