- 3 The Council on 22 May 2003 appointed Councillor Fallon to the Board of EICC, Councillor Harrold to the Board of Festival City Theatres and Councillor Longstaff to the Lyceum Board.
- 4 The terms of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 1976 have since been brought to the attention of members of the Licensing Board. The Act states that a person who is the employee of a licenceholder under the Act and any other person engaged in a business which deals in alcoholic liquor including Directors, Officers and

Employees of companies so engaged shall not act as a member of a Licensing Board for any purpose under the Act.

- 5 Councillors Harrold and Longstaff have therefore resigned from the Licensing Board and Councillor Fallon has resigned from the Board of EICC
- 6 The Council is therefore invited to appoint replacements for these members.

 - (a) appoint 2 members to the Licensing Board in place of Councillors Harrold and Longstaff; and
 - (b) appoint a member to the Board of EICC in place of Councillor Fallon
