Purpose of report

- 1 To advise the Neighbourhood Partnership of the recommendations made by the Craigentinny & Duddingston Neighbourhood Partnership Fairer Scotland Fund Funding Panel, at its meeting of 4 August 2009.

Main report

- 2 At its meeting on 4 August 2009, it was confirmed that £25,000, recorded in paragraph eight of the report presented on 16 June 2009 would be paid to projects who will use the former YWCA building as a work base. However, following further discussion, it was recommended that the allocation will now be paid directly to the landlord, Port of Leith Housing Association.
- 3 The Funding Panel recommended an allocation of **£4,500** to enable the provision of additional services for older people living in the Northfield and Willowbrae area.


