#### Purpose of report

- 1 To consider a decision which has been called in from the Executive.

#### Executive – 2 December 2003

- 2 The following decision has been called in from the Executive on a requisition by 5 Members.
- 3 **Dynamic Earth – Funding** – Details are attached at Appendix 1.

Councillor Dixon (Lead Signatory) has given the following reason for calling in this decision:

“To examine the financial risk to the Council.”

- 4 A Scrutiny Panel may only continue consideration of a called-in decision to a further meeting with the consent of the Executive or relevant Executive Member. It is expected that the Scrutiny Panel Convener and the relevant Executive Member will reach agreement on the time allowed to scrutinise called-in decisions. But the minimum time will always be at least one full scrutiny cycle.

#### For Decision

- 5 To review the decision(s) of the Executive and
  - to submit comments or recommendations to the Executive and/or
  - to let the decision be implemented.

- 6 Where the Panel agrees to let the decision be implemented on a majority vote, the matter may be called up to the full Council if not less than a quarter of the members present so require.
