1 Complaint Against a Senior Police Officer

The Sub-Committee resolved, in terms of Section 50(A)(4) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973, that the public be excluded from the meeting during consideration of the following item of business on the grounds that it involved the disclosure of exempt information as defined in Paragraph 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 7(A) of the Act.

Details were given of a formal complaint made against a Senior Police Officer of Lothian and Borders Police Force in terms of the Police (Conduct) (Senior Officers) (Scotland) Regulations 1999.

Decision

Having considered the written material submitted in relation to the complaint, the Sub-Committee resolved that the complaint against the Senior Police Officer was unfounded and that no action be taken under these Regulations in relation to the matter. Reasons for the decision are given in the Confidential Statement, signed by the Convener, as relative to this minute.
