Section 4(1) of the 1994 Act requires the Council to elect a Convener from among the councillors who shall be known by the title "Lord Provost".

4 Election of Depute Convener

Section 4(2) of the 1994 Act provides a discretion to the Council to elect a Depute Convener.

5 Election of Bailies

Standing Order 3 allows the election of Bailies, if the Council so chooses.
