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1. Order of business

4. General applications and miscellaneous business

The recommendations by the Acting Head of Planning and Building Standards or other Chief Officers detailed in their reports will be approved without debate unless the Clerk to the meeting indicates otherwise during “Order of Business” at item 1 above.

- 4.1 53 Albany Street, Edinburgh - Strip off existing defective slates (mix of scotch slates, spanish etc) and re-slate entire roof in Cupa H3 type slates with new felt/metalwork. – Application no. 13/00400/LBC – report by the Acting Head of Planning and Building Standards (circulated)

It is recommended that this application be **GRANTED**.

- 4.2 2 Carrington Road (College East, Fettes College), Edinburgh - Proposed new water-based synthetic hockey pitch. – Application no. 13/00137/FUL – report by the Acting Head of Planning and Building Standards (circulated)

9. Applications for Detailed Presentation

- 9.1(a) 7 Clerk Street, Edinburgh – Demolition of the flytower, single storey queue shelter and associated structures to the rear of the auditorium of the former Odeon cinema, Clerk Street. Construction of 18 student flats on the site of the flytower and queue shelter totalling 102 bedrooms. – Application no 12/04587/FUL – report by the Acting Head of Planning and Building Standards (circulated)

It is recommended that this application be **GRANTED**.

- 9.1(b) 7 Clerk Street, Edinburgh – Demolition of the fly tower, single storey queue shelter and associated structures to the rear of the auditorium of the former Odeon cinema and infill of the existing opening in the dividing wall between the auditorium and flytower – Application no 12/04584/LBC – report by the Acting Head of Planning and Building Standards (circulated)

It is recommended that this application be **GRANTED**.

- 9.2(a) 1 to 157 North Fort Street (Fort House), Edinburgh – Construction of 94 new-build residential units, communal external space and associated roads, footpaths and landscaping. this under “Order of Business” prior to the Sub-Committee considering the request. Otherwise, ward members are not permitted to speak on applications at the meeting.

Only elected members and officers of the Council may speak at the meeting unless the item is shown as a Hearing. For Hearings, the list of individuals and/or organisations invited to speak at the meeting will be detailed in the relevant report. The Development Management Sub-Committee does not hear deputations on planning applications. For the majority of planning applications, the decision rests with the Development Management Sub-Committee. The Sub-Committee only makes recommendations to the full Council on national/major planning applications, as defined in legislation. Reports on that type of application which require a “pre-determination hearing” will explain the process.
