Executive summary

Councillor Godzik has been invited to attend the Public Sector Show 2014 in London on 13 May 2014.

The event will bring together two thousand five hundred public sector leaders and managers to examine strategies to improve public sector delivery, efficiency and value for money. It will also examine the concept of employee ownership and the mutual model, which forms one of the main principles behind government plans for public sector reform.

Due to the need to confirm travel plans, the Director of Corporate Governance, in consultation with the Convener of the Finance and Resources Committee, approved the visit to London under urgency procedures set out at paragraph 3.1 of the Committee Terms of Reference.
