 - Edinburgh & Lothians Greenspace Trust (ELGT): Ross Woodside (Presentation)
 - A voting process was undertaken during February 2016. This enabled local people to identify their 'preferred draft park design' (one of three draft plans), and to choose one of the two nominated proposed 'park names'
 - ELGT will outline the results of voting on the three proposed plans and identify any recurring general comments and/or concerns, to allow the NP to consider if it wishes to include any 'comments' with the submission of its final preferred design option.
 - Based on the overall findings, ELGT will present a '**final composite design plan**' which aims to incorporate the main themes and the local choices identified both during the initial design stage, and voting on the three draft design plans.

- The **NP will agree a final decision on the preferred park plan and park name for submission to Communities & Families.**
- The NP's 'preferred design and park name' will be input into the next stage of the process which includes detailed design and full planning process. The new park is expected to be delivered in 2018.
