



C&D NP Community Safety Sub-Group Briefing Note:

Neighbourhood Partnership 17 March 2016

The C&D Community Safety Sub- Group would like to advise the Craigentenny & Duddingston Neighbourhood Partnership of the following items of business:

- In line with sub-group member requests, the Community Safety team will provide case examples of recent complaints & investigations undertaken by Officers. This will help sub-group members to familiarise themselves with some of the themes of the work of Community Safety teams. This will replace some higher level statistical information which has been provided until now.
- As part of the East Neighbourhood's 'Spring into March' initiative, Community Safety, in partnership with Housing & Regulatory Services & Police Scotland, **a community 'drop in' at Restalrig & Lochend Community Hub has been booked for Wednesday 13 April 2016, from 10am to 1pm.** The event will be advertised widely, including the Speaker, and it is hoped to attract as many residents as possible.
- In response to concerns raised by Police Scotland about an increase in 'Hate' incidents in the city especially amongst the female Muslim community, the East Neighbourhood Community Improvement Partnership is in the process of arranging a programme of Equality & Diversity training, including an important 'Hate' element. It is intended that these sessions will be helpful to staff, community representatives and Registered Tenant Organisations. Invitations will follow as soon as the training plan is agreed.
