1. Chair

Decision

In the absence of the Convenor (Councillor Bridgman) the Vice-Convenor (Councillor Blacklock) convened the meeting.

2. Proposed 'Stand Up To Racism and Fascism' Parade and Rally 20 March 2016

The Licensing Sub-Committee at its meeting on 4 March 2015 had continued consideration of a notification of a proposed march and rally to take place on Sunday 20 March 2016, to allow further discussion to take place on the proposed route.

Gordon Davie (Event Organiser) was heard.

Decision

To make an order in respect of the proposed 'Stand Up to Racism and Fascism' Parade and Rally on Sunday 20 March 2016, start time 13.30 hrs to dispersal at 15.15 hrs, subject to the Council's standard conditions, and to impose the following:

1. The parade shall proceed in accordance with the following route: muster at Mound Place at 12.30 hrs, set off at 13.30 hrs from Mound Place, into North Bank Street, into St Giles Street, into the High Street and dispersal at 15.15 hrs.
2. The conditions agreed by the Chief Constable shall be applied, and
3. A condition that the organisers would have stewards at the Mound Precinct to direct participants to the assembly area.
4. To note the organisers agreement to advertise the assembly point and the new route.
5. The organiser would adhere to the recommendations of the Events Planning and Operations Group.
