

Licensing Sub-Committee of the Regulatory Committee

Present

1. Request for Fee Reduction – Market Operator Licence

Details were provided of a request by the meadows Festival Association for a reduction of the fee paid for a Market Operators Licence.

The applicant and the appropriate Council officers were heard.

Decision

- 1) To note the terms of the request.
- 2) To agree a fee of £750.00 for this year.
- 3) To advise the applicant to consider siting of the event outside the Ward 11 boundary in future years or that they should ensure the normal licence fee was included in future budgets for the event.

2. Request for Approval of Clean Motion ZBRS45 – Electric Tricycle as Private Hire Car – eKogoose Ltd

Details were provided of a request by eKogoose Ltd for approval of the Clean Motion ZBRS45 Electric Tricycle, which had capacity to carry two passengers plus a driver, for use as a Private Hire Car.

It was the intention of the applicant to provide tours lasting between 1 – 1.5 hours in the Old and New Town areas. The business hoped to extend to carry passengers for “a variety of other purposes”.

The Clean Motion ZBRS45 Electric Tricycle did not conform to the current licensing conditions, which were not designed to accommodate a vehicle of this type nor the intended operation of the applicant.

If the applicant was successful with the application it was the intention to immediately license a further two vehicles.

Motion

To refuse the application in terms of Paragraph 5(3)(d) of Schedule 1 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982, being there is other good reason for refusing the

application, as the vehicle does not comply with the Council's licensing conditions for Private Hire Car Vehicles.
