Pop Up Bob has been used in areas across Scotland to help discourage speeding and is one of many tools implemented by Police Scotland and local authorities to improve road safety.

Alongside highvisibility patrols and safety cameras, the Pop Up Bob prop is used in areas to help deter speeding and is a visual reminder to drivers to make sure that they drive in a responsible manner.
