How to organise your pledge tree

- Get in touch with the Council's Active Travel and Road Safety team to let them know you want to organise a pledge tree. They'll arrange a time for you to collect the tree.

- 2. On the event day, place the tree in an area where people can see it. Talk to passers-by and encourage them to write a message on a label and then hang it on the tree.
- When asking people to make their pledge, ask them to write why 20mph is important to them.
