What are the main impacts of this option on rights?

None. All children will still be able to access their entitlement to 600 hours early learning and childcare.

What are the main impacts of this option on equality?

There will be no disproportionate impacts on specific equalities groups.

What are the main recommendations to address either the positive or negative impacts?

Limiting the increase in charges while still maintaining a level of subsidy from the Council.

We have increased the funding available through the pre-school grant to parents who buy additional hours in a nursery similar to Cowgate. Cowgate is a unique nursery providing a service similar to nurseries in the private sector. The increase will bring the costs in line with some of our partner nurseries in the private sector.
