Objection or Representation to a Temporary Civic Licence

There is no statutory objections process for applications for temporary licences however the Council may consider representations received in connection with such applications in the course of making a decision on the temporary application. If the Council decide to do so copies of representations will be forwarded to applicants. In addition the Council will investigate any complaints about any activity carried out under a temporary licence. Queries or complaints about activities covered by temporary licences should be made in writing to the Council's Licensing Section, 249 High Street, Edinburgh, EH1 1YJ.
