### ARRANGEMENT OF ARTICLES

### PART 1

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### SCHEDULE 3A

### **ROADS WHERE WAITING IS RESTRICTED**

SECTION 1

Central Zone

For the purposes of the application of this Order to any restricted road specified in this Section of this Schedule the expression:

"restricted hours" means in relation to the lengths of road specified in this Section of this Schedule and there prefixed by the letters:

- i) "P" the period between 7.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive and between 8.00 am and 6.30 pm on Saturdays.
- ii) "X" the whole period of 24 hours of every day.
  and otherwise means the period between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (during which period waiting is restricted), any such day not being a parking holiday.

### Sub-Section 1A: Zone 1

### 01 Alva Street

Between its junction with Stafford Street and its junction with Queensferry Street.

### 02 Belford Road

Between its junction with Douglas Gardens and its junction with Queensferry Street including that part named Lynedoch Place, including :

North side.

- (i) X from the apex of the junction of the north kerbline of Belford Road and the south kerbline of Hawthornbank Lane for a distance of 10 metres or thereby eastwards
- (ii) X from a point 13 metres or thereby east of the east kerbline of Sunbury Street for a distance of 30 metres or thereby eastwards into Hawthornbank Lane.

South side,

X from the extended north-east kerbline of Douglas Gardens for a distance of 17 metres or thereby eastwards.

### 03 Charlotte Lane

Between its junction with Randolph Place and its junction with Queensferry Street including:-East side,

Between its junction with Palmerston Place and its junction with Drumsheugh Gardens and Walker Street.

### 05 Coates Crescent

Between its junction with Shandwick Place and its junction with West Maitland Street including, East side,

(i) X from a point 9 metres or thereby north of the north kerbline of Haymarket Terrace for a distance of 3 metres or thereby northwards.

West side,

(i) X from a point 9 metres or thereby north of the north kerbline of Haymarket Terrace for a distance of 3 metres or thereby northwards.

### 06 Coates Gardens

Between its junction with Haymarket Terrace and its junction with Glencairn Crescent and Eglinton Crescent, including,

East side,

(i) X from a point 9 metres or thereby north of the north kerbline of Haymarket Terrace for a distance of 3 metres or thereby northwards.

### West side,

(ii) X from a point 9 metres or thereby north of the north kerbline of Haymarket Terrace for a distance of 3 metres or thereby northwards."

### 07 Douglas Crescent

From its junction with Randolph Place to end of cul-de-sac including:

East side.

(i) X from the north building line of West Register House for a distance of 25 metres or thereby southwards.

### 29 Randolph Place

Between its junction with Queensferry Street and its junction with Randolph Lane and Charlotte Lane, including –

(i) X from the west kerbline of Charlotte Lane for a distance of 5 metres or thereby westwards

30 Rosebery Crescent

Between its junction with Haymarket Terrace (Clifton Terrace) and its junction with Lansdowne Crescent including,

### West side,

(i) X from a point 14 metres or thereby north of the extended north kerbline of Haymarket Terrace for a distance of 3 metres or thereby northwards.

### 31 Rosebery Crescent Lane

From its junction with Rosebery Crescent to end of cul-de-sac.

### 32 Rothesay Mews

From its junction with Palmerston Place to end of cul-de-sac including:

South-west side,

(i) X from the extended north-west kerbline of Rothesay Place for a distance of 49 metres or thereby north-westwards.

### 33 Rothesay Place

Between its junction with Palmerston Place and its junction with Drumsheugh Gardens.

### 34 Rothesay Terrace

Between its junction with Palmerston Place and its junction with Drumsheugh Gardens.

### 35 Stafford Street

Between its junction with Melville Street and its junction with Shandwick Place, including:
South-west side.

(i) X from the south-east kerbline of William Street for a distance of 30 metres or thereby south-eastwards.

### 36 Torphichen Place Lane

The whole street from its junction with Torphichen Place.

### 37 Walker Street

(a) Between its junction with Drumsheugh Gardens and Chester Street and its junction with Melville Crescent, including:

North-east side,

(i) X from a point 2 metres or thereby north-west of the north kerbline of Melville Crescent south-eastwards then eastwards to a point in Melville Crescent 4 metres or thereby east of the north-east kerbline of Walker Street.

South-west side,

- (i) X from a point 2 metres or thereby north-west of the west kerbline of Melville Crescent south-eastwards then southwards to a point in Melville Crescent 3 metres or thereby south of the south-west kerbline of Walker Street.
- (b) Between its junction with Melville Crescent and its junction with Coates Crescent, including:

### SECTION 1

### Central Zone

In relation to a parking place described in this Section of this Schedule, the expressions:

### "permitted hours" means:

- (a) for vehicles of resident permit holders and of visitor permit holders the period between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (any such day not being a parking holiday);
- (b) for vehicles of trades' permit holders the period between 9.00 am and 4.30 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (any such day not being a parking holiday);

"m" means metre.

"A" (angle) in column 5 means at an angle of 60 degrees to the edge of the carriageway.

"T" (transverse) in column 5 means at an angle of 90 degrees to the centre line of the road, or as the case may be, to the edge of the carriageway.

## THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (EDINBURGH CITY CAR CLUB) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 1998 - TO/E/97/79

The City of Edinburgh Council in exercise of their powers under sections 1 (1) and 2 (1) to (3), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (which Act as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

### 1. Citation and Commencement:-

This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Edinburgh City Car Club) Traffic Regulation Order 1998" and shall come into operation on the Fourteenth day of December Nineteen hundred and Ninety eight.

### 2. Interpretation:-

- (a) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment.
- (b) "Article" means an article of this Order;

"Chief Constable" means the Chief Constable for the Lothian and Borders police area;

"City Car Club vehicle" means a vehicle provided for the use of persons, who have paid the relevant membership fee and by means of an advance booking system may have access to the vehicle for a specified period and which displays the relevant identification;

"Council" means The City of Edinburgh Council;

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a City Car Club parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in such a parking place;

"m" means metre:

"Parking attendant" means a person employed by the roads authority as a parking attendant in pursuance of section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic Act 1991;

"Parking space" means a space provided for the leaving of a vehicle in a City Car Club parking place;

"relevant identification" means a badge issued by the City of Edinburgh Council indicating that the car is part of the fleet of vehicles owned and operated by the City Car Club and valid for use in the parking places designated in this Order for the parking of these vehicles;

"Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order;

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the 1984 Act and includes any line or mark on a road for conveying warnings, information, requirements, restrictions or prohibitions;

"vehicle" means a motor vehicle.

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# THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (EDINBURGH TRAM) (TRAFFIC REGULATION; RESTRICTIONS ON WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING, AND PARKING PLACES) DESIGNATION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2010 TRO/09/60B

### **PART I**

### GENERAL

The City of Edinburgh Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46, 49 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and as modified by the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (City of Edinburgh) Designation Order 1998 (S.S.I. 1998/1539), as amended, (which Act as so amended and modified is hereafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, taking into account Section 122 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

### 1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as The City of Edinburgh Council (Edinburgh Tram) (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, and Parking Places)
Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2010 and shall come into operation on 31 January 2014.

### 2. Interpretation

In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"Article" means an article to this Order;

"carriageway" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, as amended;

"Chief Constable" means the Chief Constable of the police authority for the Lothian and Borders police area;

"Council" means The City of Edinburgh Council as the local authority for The City of Edinburgh area:

"Director of Services for Communities" means the Director of Services for Communities of the local authority;

"driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place or a loading and unloading place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in such a parking place or loading and unloading place;

"electronic communications apparatus" has the same meaning as in Schedule 2 to the Communications Act 2003;

### AREAS ON ROADS DESIGNATED AS LOADING AND UNLOADING PLACES

For the purposes of the application of this Order to any loading and unloading place specified in this Schedule the expression:

"permitted hours" means, in relation to the lengths of road specified in this Schedule and there prefixed by the letter:

"X" means the period between 7.30am and 6.30pm Mondays to Sundays inclusive any such day not being a public holiday;

"S" means the period between;

- a) 8.00pm and 10.00am the flowing day Mondays to Sundays inclusive from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> July, or
- b) 8.00pm and 9.00am the following day Mondays to Sundays inclusive from 1<sup>st</sup> August to 31<sup>st</sup> August, or
- c) 8.00pm and 10.00am the following day Mondays to Sundays inclusive from 1<sup>st</sup> September to 30<sup>th</sup> November, or
- d) 8.00pm and 9.00am the following day Mondays to Sundays inclusive from 1<sup>st</sup> December to 31<sup>st</sup> December,

in any year.

and otherwise means the whole period of twenty-four hours of every day, any such day not being a public holiday.

"A" (angle) in column 4 means at an angle of 60 degrees to the edge of the carriageway with the front wheels nearest to the said edge; and

"T" (transverse) in column 4 means at an angle of 90 degrees to the centreline of the street or, as the case may be, edge of the carriageway.
