The City of Edinburgh Council (City Centre West Cycle Link, Haymarket to Queensferry Street, Edinburgh) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles and Turning, One-Way Roads and Weight Limit) Traffic Regulation Order 201_ - TRO/18/92B The Council propose to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended to introduce/amend the following moving traffic restrictions to accommodate the city centre east to west cycle link:

- 1. Introduce a Prohibition of Motor Vehicles on Charlotte Ln from 12:00 pm to 05:00 am Mondays to Sundays inclusive:
- 2. Introduce a Prohibition of Turning Left from Stafford St into Melville St (heavy goods vehicles only);
- Introduce One-way restrictions (except cycles) on: Alva St (south-westwards), William St [Eastern Limb] (south-westwards), William St [Western Limb] (south-westwards), Melville Cres [Northern Limb] (eastwards), Melville Cres [Eastern Limb] (southwards), Melville Cres [Southern Limb] (westwards), Melville Cres [Western Limb] (northwards), part of Charlotte Ln (southwards) & part of Rutland Sq (north-westwards);
- 4. Introduce a Weight limit of 7.5 Tonnes on Rosebery Cres Ln (entire road)
- 5. Amend the Prohibition of Turning Right from Canning St into Shandwick Pl to exclude cycles;
- 6. Amend the One-way restrictions to exclude cycles on: Coates Cres, Stafford St & Rutland St;
- 7. Introduce additional One-way restrictions on part of Canning St (southeastwards).
