

Comments on Choices for City Plan 2030

April 2020



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Introduction

Leith Central Community Council (LCCC) is keen to engage with the City Plan 2030 process. Starting with a briefing by two Local Plan Team members on 18-03-2019 we have consulted and "workshopped" issues that "move" people living in our area (see map) and have identified those with the biggest impact.

Nearly all the important issues for our area are related to high residential density (highest in Scotland, Census 2011) and reflect recent experiences of large planning applications, as well as the cumulative, but seemingly difficult to monitor effects of many smaller planning decisions.

Specific sites and projects in or near our area that need to be included in the Draft City Plan 2030

1. We wish to see the **Powderhall Green Corridor** (conversion of disused railway line between St Mark's Park and Easter Road, and further east) safeguarded as a linear park with multiple access points (steps, ramps) connecting developments east of Easter Road to St Mark's Park and the North Edinburgh path and cycle network

- Stead's Place and land at rear: we wish this to be zoned for mixed development, appropriately scaled with respect to the topography and retaining the historic 2-storey frontage to Leith Walk
- 3. Land to rear of 139 Leith Walk: we wish to this zoned for mixed development (see our submission to the Place Brief for the site between Leith Walk & Halmyre Street)
- 4. Land at defunct Powderhall Refuse Transfer Station and neighbouring bowling greens: we wish to see this zoned for mixed development that respects the site history and with a good link to Powderhall Green Corridor and Redbraes Park to the East and a pedestrian link to the Powderhall Hall Village
- 5. **Various sites along Water of Leith**: developments here needs to be accompanied by added public transport capacity, permeability on foot and by bike (in particular across and along the river) and must not overshadow the Water of Leith Walkway or existing residential buildings
- 6. We wish to retain existing light industrial uses at Jane/Tennant Street, Arthur Street, Spey Street, Pitt Street, Graham Street, West Bowling Green Street, Manderston Street and elsewhere in LCCC area, in the knowledge that the the high residential density (and low car ownership per household) and mixed demographic of our area is underpinned by nearby employment opportunities and services provided from these sites
- 7. **Manderston/Jane Street:** we wish to see see options for a future active travel route at high level safeguarded ("**Leith Walk Highline**") to support connections from Pilrig Park and the North Edinburgh cycle network to East Edinburgh and the coast line between Marine Esplanade and Portobello
- 8. We are supportive of an **expansion of the Leith Conservation Area** to encompass the railway arches and the old cinema building on Jane Street and Manderston Street, subject to wider consultation.

New or updated policies that need to be included in the Draft City Plan 2030

- 9. In general, we wish to see strengthened and explicit policies pertaining to **limiting student housing and holiday lets** to prevent transient populations undermining the social fabric that underpins and supports the high density of our area.
- 10. This should be accompanied by timely monitoring of capacity (headcount), units and footprint dedicated to students, tourist populations to enable early detection of negative impact on the availability of permanent residential units and skewed demand (towards transient population needs) at local shops.
- 11. We seek new and clearer policies on **height and density**. For our area this should include specifically:
 - new developments to **match prevailing/neighbouring height/density** without recourse to "tricks" like set back top floors
 - any excess height to be matched by commensurate increases in quality public green amenity space, new vistas, and increases in social infrastructure (library, meeting space, doctors, school, retail)
 - any increase in population density for our area resulting from a new development to be accompanied by a mandatory percentage increase in publicly accessible quality green spaces (+ other infrastructure, police, electricity, water, surface water)

- 12. All new developments should always increase and **add to permeability and connectivity** for active travel.
- 13. All new developments should have **no net car traffic impact**; this could include zero onsite parking (and CPZ in the whole area) and/or car traffic reducing and public transport measures (eg temporary subsidies for bus route, as for Ocean Terminal) in the vicinity (defined as: 5 minutes walking distance)
- 14. We wish to see explicit **presumption against residential development in flood areas** without in-principle support from SEPA.
- 15. We wish to see a clear policy that **prevents conversions of front gardens into private parking**.
- 16. We wish to see a **presumption against materially similar planning applications for the same site** after refusal in the previous six months.
- 17. CP30 should provide robust guidance in anticipation of CPO and CSO powers.
- 18. We wish to see a clear definition of **truly affordable housing** as a ratio of the National Living Wage.
- 19. CP30 should provide for the introduction of on-street logistics hubs (with lockers) to reduce traffic from delivery vans and to support shop deliveries; this requires supporting measures (well-maintained, smooth pavements and good road crossings for trolleys) which will also benefit and prioritise pedestrian traffic.

Main Issues Report and Open Data

- 20. We are keen on an evidence based Local Plan which is supported by fine-grained "as is" data for our area (and sub-areas, where available) alongside comparable data from other cities/areas. This should include current (most recent) data and changes (eg 2011-2019) on:
 - car use by household/location
 - density by sub-area (eg city block)
 - demographics: average household size; age structure
 - ratios: doctors/1000; school places/1000, usable green space area sqft/1000; average dwelling sqft/adult
 - schedule of Vacant and Derelict Land (location/address, sqft, historical uses)
 - map and analysis of all green space and brownfield sites
 - residential units planned/completed broken down by number of bedrooms
 - office/industrial uses: location with categories of trade
 - student housing: number of sites and units; dates of occupation
 - tourist population: using sample/proxy data from http://insideairbnb.com/edinburgh/
 - monitor residential sites that are within 20 minutes of active travel or public transport from employment centres; percentage that are further away (consider target ratios)
