CHOICES FOR CITY PLAN 2030 – REPRESENTATION

Montagu Evans LLP act on behalf of Edinburgh Napier University ('ENU').

ENU have been a higher education provider in the city since 1964 and in the 2018/19 academic year, a total of 19,470 students were enrolled at the University (14,098 on Campus).

As a key stakeholder within Edinburgh, ENU welcome the opportunity to respond to the Main Issues Report.

However, the University are currently managing a number of unforeseen issues arising from the on-going Covid-19 pandemic. This has delayed the production of ENU's new University Strategy, which will include critical information regarding the future of the University and once published, will inform the progression of a new Estates Strategy.

In these unprecedented times, ENU submit this representation to the City of Edinburgh Council (CEC) to provide high level observations on the content of the Choices 2030 paper, and will follow up with further and more detailed comment relative to the approach as subsequently agreed in the new University Strategy as and when this is published later in 2020.

EDINBURGH NAPIER UNIVERSITY

ENU have three main campuses at Sighthill, Merchiston and Craiglockhart. In recent years the University has worked to condense and consolidate its estate to focus on improving the quality of each campus within the city. The University also have interests at Merchiston Avenue and Seven Hills Industrial Estate in Edinburgh, and manage approximately 1200 student accommodation bed spaces for occupation by their students.

The University experience a high demand for their existing student residences at Bainfield Drive, Orwell Terrace and Slateford Road, with an occupancy rate of 97%. At present ENU do not require any further bed spaces. However, the University do wish to monitor this position moving forward to ensure that their own provision can continue to work effectively in conjunction with wider private sector purpose built student accommodation (PBSA) and House in Multiple Occupation stock.

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The University expect that any future growth in staff and student numbers can be accommodated through using the existing University estate more efficiently, with any additional expansion space or facilities considered on an opportunity basis. ENU's preferred development approach is to refurbish and reuse existing buildings and initial feasibility studies undertaken by the University suggest that there is some capacity for further development at each of their three main campuses specifically possible acquisition of land around the University's Sighthill Campus

CHOICES

ENU consider that the following Choices are most relevant to them and that if implemented, have the greatest potential to impact the University's emerging Estate Strategy.

Choice 2 – Improving the Quality, Density and Accessibility of Development

ENU are supportive of this Choice. ENU agree that increasing the density of development will ensure that the limited land available in Edinburgh's urban areas is developed as efficiently as possible.

Choice 3 – Delivering Carbon Neutral Buildings

ENU seek to be environmentally sustainable and resilient, and are currently considered to be one of the greenest universities in the UK. ENU are therefore supportive of this Choice.

Choice 4 – Creating Place Briefs and Supporting the Use of Local Plan Plans in Our Communities

ENU already actively engage with the Council through the relevant neighbourhood partnerships and the Community Council's around each of their three main campuses. ENU consider these to be effective methods of engagement and have a desire to further extend this collaboration with the Council and other partners by hosting and/or sharing facilities. If Local Place Plans are introduced, ENU would wish to further consider how these might relate to existing structures and relationships, and the merits of further involvement as appropriate.

Choice 10 – Creating Sustainable Communities

ENU have some concerns in relation to Choice 10 ENU would suggest that the development of any future policy for assessing PBSA should be based on the acceptability of PBSA in principle on a criteria based approach. ENU do not have any strong view as to the maximum number of studios that should be permitted as part of a PBSA development, and this should be driven by market and demand factors.

Choice 13 – Supporting Inclusive Growth, Innovation, Universities & Culture

ENU are supportive of this Choice and would welcome the introduction of a specific policy that supports innovation and universities in the city.

Choice 14 – Delivering West Edinburgh

ENU are an existing stakeholder in West Edinburgh with a substantial presence in Sighthill. ENU recently welcomed the opportunity to respond to the recent 'West Edinburgh Spatial Strategy for Inclusive Growth'. It is



the desire of ENU to redevelop and build at their existing campuses where possible. However, in the long term, the University may consider other alternative sites.

Given the existing presence and activity of the University in West Edinburgh, ENU would request that their requirements are considered by the Council in any future strategy for development, growth or expansion in the area.

SUMMARY

ENU have been an established higher education provider in Edinburgh for over 50 years, adding to the social, cultural and economic capital of the city.

The University submit this representation as a positive contribution to the plan making process and look forward to providing further input as their new Strategy and Estate Strategy emerge.

The University supports Choices 2, 3, 4, 13 and 14 in principle, but would ask that in respect of Choice 10 further work is undertaken by the Council in partnership with higher education and PBSA providers to develop a new policy for considering future student accommodation proposals.

We trust that the above will be given due regard in the process of preparing the new City Plan 2030. We would be grateful to be kept advised of future opportunities to engage in the process and would be pleased to meet with the Council as required to further discuss matters.
