Message from Broomhouse PS and NHS Lothian

As you may already know, we are aware of a person in the school who has tested positive for COVID-19. We have been working closely with NHS Test and Protect and following all national guidance.

Persons have now been contacted because they have been in close and sustained contact with the case and the tracking process is now complete.

These contacts will need to self isolate and appropriate guidance and advice has been given.

For parents/carers of pupils: If you have not been contacted and your child remains well, you should continue to follow the school's existing arrangements for your child i.e. remote learning for most children. The school will reopen after the holiday to specific categories of children e.g. children of key workers as approved by the school.

<u>For school staff</u>: If you have not been contacted and you remain well, you should continue to follow the school's existing arrangements for when the school reopens after the holiday.

Enhanced cleaning and infection control measures are in place in line with national guidance. The school is safe and will reopen after the holiday.

If you have any concerns in the meantime, or if you need to book a COVID-19 test because you or a child has developed symptoms (high temperature, a new continuous cough and/or a loss or change in sense of smell or taste) please visit the NHS Inform website <u>www.nhsinform.scot</u> or for non-clinical advice call 0800 028 2816.

Please note that a test should only ever be booked if you or a child has these specifics symptoms.

Remember to stay at home if anyone in the household has symptoms of COVID-19.
