Where does the Council's income come from?

The Council's budget for 2021/22 is £1,143.2 million. Council Tax funds 27.2% (£311.3 million) of this with 52.0% coming from Government Grants and 20.8% from Non-Domestic Rates.

Comparison with Government provision for planned spending

The expenditure figure for the Council used by the Scottish Government in Aggregate External Finance (Total Central Government Support) calculations is £1,002.489m, which provides for a spend of £3,932 per dwelling. The Council's budget provides for a spend of £4,264 per dwelling.
