THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CORSTORPHINE HIGH AREA, EDINBURGH)
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2021 -
TEMP/21/47

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Corstorphine High Area, Edinburgh) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2021" and shall come into operation on the Fourteenth day of June Two thousand and twenty-one and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirteenth day of December Two thousand and twenty-two. The circumstances necessitating the restrictions within this Order, as stated in Article 3, will be subject to ongoing review and should it be determined that the restrictions are no longer required, then at that time the temporary restrictions shall be revoked by notice, under a separate Order.
2. (a) In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "parking attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 - "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) act 1984 and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road;
 - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) act 1984;(b) References in this Order to a disabled person, to a disabled person's badge, to a disabled person's vehicle and to a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position shall be construed in accordance with the 1984 Act, The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 and The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate improved safety for pedestrians and cyclists during the current Covid-19 pandemic, supporting social distancing so that people can safely walk, wheel or cycle, no person shall, except with the permission of a Parking Attendant: -
 - (a) cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on any part of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order; and
 - (b) cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any part of:
 - (i) **Featherhall Avenue (both sides)**: from a point 65 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerblines of Featherhall Crescent South, southwards for a distance of 39 metres or thereby;
 - (ii) **Corstorphine High Street (North side)**: from a point 68 metres or thereby east of the extended eastern kerblines of Ladywell Avenue, eastwards for a distance of 44 metres or thereby;
 - (iii) **Corstorphine High Street (North side)**: from a point 15 metres or thereby west of the extended western kerblines of Manse Road, westwards for a distance of 62 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3(b) shall apply: -
 - (a) so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any road described in said Schedule while the vehicle is in actual use for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or while loading or unloading goods from or to premises adjoining the said road; provided that:
 - i. no such vehicle so engaged shall wait for a period of more than thirty minutes in the same place; and
 - ii. no such vehicle so engaged shall return to the same place, unless a period of more than thirty minutes has elapsed since the termination of the previous waiting period.
 - (b) to a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge, provided that said vehicle is being used by, or for the conveyance of, the holder of a valid disabled person's badge.

5. Whilst this Order continues in force, The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018 will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3 of this Order.

SCHEDULE

ROADS ON WHICH WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING WILL BE PROHIBITED

Ladywell Road (North side) (i) from the extended western kerbline of Featherhall Avenue, westwards for a distance of 16 metres or thereby

Corstorphine High Street (South side) (i) from a point 4 metres or thereby west of the extended western kerbline of Ladywell Avenue, westwards for a distance 45 metres or thereby; (ii) from a point 69 metres or thereby east of the extended eastern kerbline of Ladywell Avenue, eastwards for a distance of 44 metres or thereby; (iii) from a point 48 metres or thereby west of the extended western kerbline of Orchardfield Avenue, Westwards for a distance of 23 metres or thereby; (iv) from a point 4 metres or thereby east of the extended eastern kerbline of Ladywell Avenue, eastwards for a distance of 11 metres or thereby; **(North side)** (i) from the junction with Featherhall Avenue, eastwards for a distance 82 metres or thereby; (ii) from a point 78 metres or thereby east of the extended eastern kerbline of Manse Road, eastwards for a distance of 16 metres or thereby

Ladywell Avenue (West side): (i) from a point 18 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Dovecot Road, southwards for a distance of 45 metres or thereby; **(East side):** from its junction with Dovecot Road, northwards for a distance of 9 metres or thereby; (ii) from its junction with Dovecot Road, southwards for a distance of 8 metres or thereby

Dovecot Road (North side): (i) from a point 79 metres or thereby east of the extended eastern kerbline of Ladywell Avenue, eastwards for a distance 14 metres or thereby; (ii) from the extended eastern kerbline of Ladywell Avenue, eastwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby; **(South side):** from the extended eastern kerbline of Ladywell Avenue, north-eastwards for a distance of 19 metres or thereby

Featherhall Avenue (West side): (i) from its junction with Ladywell Road, northwards for a distance of 17 metres or thereby; **(East Side):** (i) from its junction with Ladywell Road, northwards for a distance of 14 metres or thereby
