THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (LOGANLEA DRIVE & BRUNSWICK ROAD,
EDINBURGH) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION)
ORDER 2021 - TEMP/21/79

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Loganlea Drive & Brunswick Road, Edinburgh) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2021" and shall come into operation on the First day of June Two thousand and twenty-one and shall remain in force up to and including the Ninth day of November Two thousand and twenty-two. The circumstances necessitating the restrictions within this Order, as stated in Article 2, will be subject to ongoing review and should it be determined that the restrictions are no longer required, then at that time the temporary restrictions shall be revoked by notice, under a separate Order.
2. For improved safety for pedestrians and cyclists during the current Covid-19 pandemic, supporting social distancing so that people can safely walk, wheel or cycle, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works), drive or cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven on the length of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order otherwise than in the direction specified opposite in the corresponding line of column 2 of the said Schedule.

Length of Road in Edinburgh	Direction
Loganlea Drive between its junction with Craigentiny Road and its eastern junction of Loganlea Avenue.	North-east to South-west
Brunswick Road between its junction with East Montgomery Place and its junction with Brunswick Place.	North-east to South-west then, South-east to North-west
