THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (BUCCLEUCH STREET AREA, EDINBURGH) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2021 - TEMP/21/116

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Buccleuch Street Area, Edinburgh) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2021" and shall come into operation on the Sixteenth day of July Two thousand and twenty-one and shall remain in force up to and including the Fifteenth day of January Two thousand and twenty-three. The circumstances necessitating the restrictions within this Order, to facilitate improved safety for pedestrians and cyclists during the current Covid-19 pandemic, supporting social distancing so that people can safely walk, wheel or cycle, will be subject to ongoing review and should it be determined that the restrictions are no longer required, then at that time the temporary restrictions shall be revoked by notice, under a separate Order.
2. (a) In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "parking attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 - "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) act 1984 and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road;
 - "Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order; and(b) References in this Order to a disabled person, to a disabled person's badge, to a disabled person's vehicle and to a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position shall be construed in accordance with the 1984 Act, The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 and The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall, except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle:-
 - (a) to wait or load onto or unload, at any time, from any vehicle on any part of the roads described in the Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (b) to wait, at any time, or load onto and unload from any vehicle between the hours of 07:30 to 09:30 and 16:00 to 18:30, Monday to Friday, on any part of the roads described in the Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. Nothing in
 - (a) Article 3 shall apply to vehicles being used in the service of the Police, Ambulance or Fire Service;
 - (b) Article 3(b) except between 07:30 to 09:30 and 16:00 to 18:30, Monday to Friday, shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any road described in said Article while the vehicle is in actual use for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or while loading or unloading goods from or to premises adjoining the said road; provided that:
 - i. no such vehicle so engaged shall wait for a period of more than thirty minutes in the same place; and
 - ii. no such vehicle so engaged shall return to the same place, unless a period of more than thirty minutes has elapsed since the termination of the previous waiting period.
 - (c) Article 3(b) except between 07:30 to 09:30 and 16:00 to 18:30, Monday to Friday, shall apply to a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge, provided that said vehicle is being used by, or for the conveyance of, the holder of a valid disabled person's badge.

5. Whilst this Order continues in force, "The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018" will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3 of this Order.
6. The City of Edinburgh Council (Buccleuch Street Area, Edinburgh) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2020 – TEMP/20/181 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

ROADS ON WHICH WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING WILL BE PROHIBITED

Hope Park Crescent: (a) west side: (i) from a point 15 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Melville Drive, northwards for a distance of 34 metres or thereby.

Buccleuch Street: (a) west side: (i) from a point 94 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Melville Drive, north-westerly for a distance of 3 metres or thereby ; (ii) from a point 119 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Melville Drive, north-westerly for a distance of 37 metres or thereby; (iii) from a point 10 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Meadow Lane, northwards for a distance of 55 metres or thereby to its junction with Buccleuch Place; (iv) from a point 36 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Buccleuch Place, northwards for a distance of 54 metres or thereby; (v) from a point 9 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerbline of Windmill Street, southwards for a distance of 18 metres or thereby; **(b) east side:** (i) from a point 93 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Gifford Park, southwards for a distance of 54 metres or thereby.

Potterrow: (a) west side: (i) from a point 14 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Marshall Street , northwards for a distance of 22 metres or thereby; **(b) west and south sides:** (i) from the north kerbline of the entrance to the Royal Medical Society northwards and then westwards for a distance of 118 metres or thereby; **(c) east side:** (i) from a point 56 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of West Nicholson Street, northwards and then westwards for a distance of 8 metres or thereby.

Teviot Place: (south side) (i) from the eastern kerbline of the taxi stand, eastwards for a distance of 48 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 2

ROADS ON WHICH WAITING AT ANY TIME, LOADING & UNLOADING BETWEEN 07:30 TO 9:30 AND 16:00 TO 18:30 MONDAY TO FRIDAY, WILL BE PROHIBITED

Potterrow (east side): (i) from a point 44 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of West Nicholson Street, northwards for a distance of 12 metres or thereby; (ii) from a point 64 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of West Nicholson Street, northwards for a distance of 8 metres or thereby.

Buccleuch Street (east side): (i) from a point 168 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Gifford Park, southwards for a distance of 75 metres or thereby; (ii) from a point 8 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerbline of Gifford Park, southwards for a distance of 41 metres or thereby.
