THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CAUSEWAYSIDE AREA, EDINBURGH)
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2021 -
TEMP/21/117

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Causewayside Area, Edinburgh) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2021" and shall come into operation on the Sixteenth day of July Two thousand and twenty-one and shall remain in force up to and including the Fifteenth day of January Two thousand and twenty-three. The circumstances necessitating the restrictions within this Order, as stated in Article 2, will be subject to ongoing review and should it be determined that the restrictions are no longer required, then at that time the temporary restrictions shall be revoked by notice, under a separate Order.
2. (a) In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "Chief Constable" means the Chief Constable for the Police Scotland Area;
 - "local authority" means The City of Edinburgh Council;
 - "parking attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 - "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) act 1984 and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road;(b) References in this Order to a disabled person, to a disabled person's badge, to a disabled person's vehicle and to a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position shall be construed in accordance with the 1984 Act, The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 and The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate improved safety for pedestrians and cyclists during the current Covid-19 pandemic, supporting social distancing, no person shall, except with the permission of a Parking Attendant:-
 - (a) cause or permit any vehicle to wait, at any time, or load onto or unload from any vehicle between 07:30 to 9:30 hours and 16:00 to 18:30 hours, Monday to Friday, on any part of the roads described in Schedule 1 to this Order; and
 - (b) cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle, at any time, on any part of the roads described in Schedule 2 to this Order;
 - (c) cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 07:30 to 18:30, Monday to Friday and 08:00 to 13:30, Saturday, or load onto or unload from any vehicle between 07:30 to 09:30 hours and 16:00 to 18:30 hours, Monday to Friday on **Ratcliffe Terrace, on the east side** from a point 28 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerblines of Duncan Street, southwards for a distance of 18 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in:
 - i. Article 3 of this Order shall apply to vehicles being used in the service of the Police, Ambulance or Fire Service;
 - ii. Article 3(a) and 3(c), except between 07:30 to 09:30 and 16:00 to 18:30, Monday to Friday, shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any road described in said Article while the vehicle is in actual use for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or while loading or unloading goods from or to premises adjoining the said road; provided that:
 - i. no such vehicle so engaged shall wait for a period of more than thirty minutes in the same place; and

- ii. no such vehicle so engaged shall return to the same place, unless a period of more than thirty minutes has elapsed since the termination of the previous waiting period.
- iii. Article 3(a) and 3(c) except between 07:30 to 09:30 and 16:00 to 18:30, Monday to Friday, shall apply to a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge, provided that said vehicle is being used by, or for the conveyance of, the holder of a valid disabled person's badge.

5. The City of Edinburgh Council (Causewayside Area, Edinburgh) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) (3) Order 2020 - TEMP/20/207 is hereby revoked.

6. Whilst this Order continues in force, "The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018" will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3 of this Order.

SCHEDULE 1
ROADS ON WHICH WAITING, AT ANY TIME, OR LOADING AND UNLOADING
BETWEEN 07:30 TO 09:30 HOURS AND 16:00 TO 18:30 HOURS MONDAY TO FRIDAY
WILL BE PROHIBITED

Causewayside: (a) east side: (i) from a point 15 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerbline of West Preston Street, southwards for a distance of 21 metres or thereby; (ii) from a point 56 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Salisbury Place, southwards for a distance of 19 metres or thereby; **(b) west side:** (i) from a point 43 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of the southern entrance to Kittle yards, northwards for a distance of 11 metres or thereby; (ii) from a point 76 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of the southern entrance of Kittle yards, northwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby; (iii) from a point 55 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerbline of Grange Road, southwards for a distance of 29 metres or thereby; (iv) from a point 89 metres or thereby, south of the extended southern kerbline of Grange Road, southwards for a distance of 14 metres or thereby; (v) from a point 15 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Grange Road, northwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby; (vi) from a point 46 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Grange Road, northwards for a distance of 7 metres or thereby; (vii) from a point 55 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Grange Road, northwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby; and (viii) from a point 20 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerbline of East Sciennes Street, southwards for a distance of 15 metres or thereby; and **Ratcliffe Terrace: (a) east side:** (i) from a point 62 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of West Mayfield, northwards for a distance of 5 metres or thereby; and (ii) from a point 14 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of West Mayfield, northwards for a distance of 46 metres or thereby.

SCHEDULE 2
ROADS ON WHICH WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING WILL BE PROHIBITED
AT ALL TIMES

Summerhall Crescent: (a) east side: (i) from the extended southwestern kerbline of Hope Park Terrace, southwards for a distance of 115 metres or thereby; **Summerhall Place: (a) east side:** (i) from a point 7 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerbline of Summerhall Square, southwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby; **Causewayside: (a) east side:** (i) from a point 15 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerbline of Salisbury Place, southwards for a distance of 29 metres or thereby; (ii) from a point 75 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerbline of Salisbury Place, southwards for a distance of 45 metres or thereby; **(b) west side:** (i) from a point 31 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of the entrance to 212-242 Causewayside northwards for a distance of 27 metres or thereby; (ii) from the extended northern kerbline of the southern entrance to Kittle yards northwards for a distance of 12 metres or thereby; (iii) from the extended southwestern kerbline of the southern entrance to Kittle yards northwards for a distance of 43 metres or thereby; (iv) from a point 64 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of the southern entrance to Kittle Yards northwards for a distance of 12 metres or thereby; (v) from a point 35 metres or thereby south of the extended southern kerbline of Grange Road southwards for a distance of 16 metres or thereby; (vi) from a point 25 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Grange Road northwards for a distance of 28 metres or thereby; (vii) from a point 55 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Grange Road northwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby; and (viii) from the southern kerbline of East Sciennes Street, southwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby; and **Lord Russell Place: (a) west side:** (i) from the extended northern kerbline of Sciennes Place northwards for a distance of 54 metres or thereby.
