### THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (KAIMES CROSSROADS, EDINBURGH) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2021 - TEMP/21/134.

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -


1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Kaimes Crossroads, Edinburgh) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2021" and shall come into operation on the Second day of August Two thousand and twenty-one and shall remain in force up to and including the First day of February Two thousand and twenty-three (18 months to the day). The restrictions within this Order, to facilitate improved safety for pedestrians and cyclists during the current Covid-19 pandemic, supporting social distancing so that people can safely walk, wheel or cycle, will be subject to ongoing review and should it be determined that the restrictions are no longer required, then at that time the temporary restrictions shall be revoked by notice, under a separate Order.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
  - "Article" means an Article of this Order;
  - "bus lane" has the same meaning as in Section 44(4) of the Transport (Scotland) Act 2001;
  - "parking attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
  - "pedal cycle" shall have the meaning assigned to that phrase by section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
  - "public service vehicle" shall have the meaning assigned to that phrase by section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981, and, for the purposes of this Order, applies where the said vehicle or vehicles are being operated as a Local Service, as defined in the said Act;
  - "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) act 1984 and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road; and
  - "Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order
  - "taxi" shall have the meaning given to that word by section 23 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982.
3. For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be deemed to be in, to have entered to remain in, or be proceeding or waiting in a bus lane described in Schedule 1 to this Order if any part of said bus lane is below the vehicle or its load.
4. Save as provided in Article 6, no person shall, between the hours of 07:30 to 09:30 and 16:00 to 18:30 hours, Monday to Friday, cause or permit any vehicle to be in, to enter or proceed in the bus lane described in Schedule 1 of this Order, provided that nothing in this Article shall apply to any vehicle entering or proceeding in a bus lane in order to avoid an accident, a parked vehicle or is prevented by circumstances out with their control from avoiding entering or proceeding other than in the bus lane and as soon as possible causes the vehicle to leave the bus lane.

5. Save as provided in Article 6, no person shall, except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on **Captain's Road, North side**, (i) from the extended west kerbline of Gracemount Road, westwards for a distance of 56 metres or thereby; (ii) from the extended eastern kerbline of Gracemount Road, eastwards for a distance of 54 metres or thereby; and (iii) from a point 74 metres or thereby, east of the extended east kerbline of Gracemount Road, eastwards for a distance of 111 metres or thereby.
  
6. Nothing in:
  - (a) Article 4 shall apply to public service vehicles, pedal cycles and taxis.
  - (b) Article 4 or 5 shall apply to emergency service vehicles.
  
7. The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018 is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 5 of this Order.

**SCHEDULE 1  
TEMPORARY BUS LANES**

Length of Road	Description of Section of Road Containing Temporary Bus Lane
<b>Captain's Road</b> (south side)	from a point 66 metres or thereby, west of the extended west kerbline of Southhouse Broadway, westwards for a distance of 196 metres or thereby.
