THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (SCIENNES PRIMARY SCHOOL, EDINBURGH)
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 -
TEMP/22/29

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Sciennes Primary School, Edinburgh) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on the Second day of February Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the First day of February Two thousand and twenty-three. The circumstances necessitating the restrictions within this Order, as stated in Article 3, will be subject to ongoing review and should it be determined that the restrictions are no longer required, then at that time the temporary restrictions shall be revoked by a separate Order.
2. (a) In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
"Article" means an Article of this Order;
"emergency service vehicles" means a vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;
"local authority" means The City of Edinburgh Council;
"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act; and
"road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) act 1984 and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate improved safety for pedestrians and cyclists during the current Covid-19 pandemic, supporting social distancing so that people can safely walk, wheel or cycle, no person shall, cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven on **Sciennes Road** from property number 11 at the boundary with Sciennes Primary School to the western vehicle gate of Sciennes Primary School.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles.
5. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
6. An alternative route for motor vehicles will be available by way of Tantallon Place, Hatton Place and Chalmers Crescent.
