Ward 1 - Almond

I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 1 - Almond. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 27,454 and the number of ballot papers received was 14,024 giving a percentage turnout of $51.1 \%$. There were 115 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 2,782 .
