I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 2 - Pentland Hills. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 24,312 and the number of ballot papers received was 11,266 giving a percentage turnout of $46.3 \%$. There were 179 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 2,218 .
