I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 5 - Inverleith. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 24,608 and the number of ballot papers received was 13,542 giving a percentage turnout of $55.0 \%$. There were 126 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 2,684 .
