THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (PRIDE EDINBURGH) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 - TEMP/22/116

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of the Moonwalk 2022 event, and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under section 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Pride Edinburgh) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022". The Order shall have effect from the Twenty-fifth day of June Two thousand and twenty-two, during the hours specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 2. (a) In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
 - "events related vehicles" means any vehicle authorised by City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with this event;
 - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 - "Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order; and
 - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate the holding of the Pride Edinburgh event, no person shall (as signed as affected by the event):
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto, where closures will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 2 hereto, during the times specified in the said Schedule, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated.
- 4. Nothing in the following Articles of this Order shall apply to:
 - (i) events related vehicles, in relation to Article 3(b) and the section of Holyrood Road described in Schedule 2 to this Order; and
 - (ii) emergency service vehicles in relation to Articles 3(a) and (b).
- 5. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018' will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic in respect of the closures will be by way of Chambers Street, South Bridge, Nicolson Street, Lothian Road and Melville Drive.

SCHEDULE 1 ROAD CLOSURES

From 11:30 hours to 15:00 hours on 25/06/2022 on:

(i) **Horse Wynd**; and (ii) **Queen's Drive**, between its junction with Horse Wynd to the roundabout at Broad Pavement car park.

From 12:30 hours to 15:00 hours on 25/06/2022 on:

(i) Canongate; (ii) St Mary's Street, between its junction with Canongate and its junction with Cowgate; (iii) Cowgate, between its junction with Pleasance/St Mary's Street and its junction with Candlemaker Row; (iv) Cowgatehead; (v) Candlemaker Row; (vi) Forrest Road/George IV Bridge (southbound), between its junction with Chambers Street and its junction with Candlemaker Row; (vii) George IV Bridge, between its junction with Chambers Street and its junction with Bristo Place; (viii) Bristo Place; (ix) Potterrow; (x) Marshall Street; (xi) Crichton Street; (xii) Chapel Street, between its junction with West Nicolson Street and its junction with Crichton Street; (xiii) Charles Street; and (xiv) George Square (north leg), between its junction with Crichton Street and its junction with Windmill Street.

SCHEDULE 2 PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING & UNLOADING

From 08:30 hours to 15:00 hours on 25/06/2022 on:

(i) **Holyrood Road**, *north side*, between its junction with Hammerman's Entry and its junction with Gentle's Entry (*except event related vehicles*); (ii) **Abbey Strand**; (iii) **Horse Wynd**; (iv) **Canongate**; (v) **St Mary's Street**; (vi) **Cowgate**, *both sides*, between its junction with Pleasance/St Mary's Street and its junction with Candlemaker Row; (vii) **Cowgatehead**; (viii) **Candlemaker Row**; (ix) **Forrest Road**, *both sides*, between its junction with George IV Bridge and its junction with Bristo Place; (x) **Bristo Place**; (xi) **Potterrow**; (xii) **Marshall Street**; (xiii) **Crichton Street**; (xiv) **Chapel Street**, *both sides*, between its junction with West Nicolson Street and its junction with Crichton Street; (xv) **Charles Street**; and (xvi) **George Square** (*north leg*), *both sides*, between its junction with Crichton Street and its junction with Windmill Street.
