## **Summer Holiday Food & Childcare Programme 2022**

The Scottish Government has again provided local authorities with funding for summer holiday activities. The purpose it to help children and young people connect with each other and have fun. This year the funding supports activities for children aged between 5-14 years old. The funding is being used by council services and partner organisations to provide free activity places and healthy snacks for people who are impacted by the cost of living crisis.
