THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (HILL SQUARE FRINGE FESTIVAL) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 - TEMP/22/162

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Hill Square Fringe Festival) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022". The Order shall have effect from the Twenty-ninth day of July Two thousand and twenty-two up to and including the Third day of September Two thousand and twenty-two, during the hours specified in the Article 3 of this Order.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for police, fire, or ambulance purposes;
 "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; and "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate a safe space for the attendees to the Hill Square Fringe Festival, no person shall (as signed as affected by the events):
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle *between 10:00 hours on 29/07/2022 and 08:00 hours on 03/09/2022* on: (i) Hill Square; and (ii) Hill Place (*westbound*), between its junction with Richmond Place and its junction with Hill Square, where closures will apply to the entire road unless otherwise stated; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle *between 10:00 hours on 29/07/2022 and 08:00 hours on 03/09/2022* on Hill Square, *both sides*, in its entirety.
- 4. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018' is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
- 5. Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained.
