THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (BLACKET AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 – TEMP/22/158

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -


1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Blacket Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the Eighth day of August Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Fifth day of February Two thousand and twenty-three.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for police, fire, or ambulance purposes;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and  
“Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate CityFibre ducting works, (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall: -
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on sections of the roads described in Schedule 1 of this Order, where closures will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on (i) **Dryden Place**; (ii) **Newington Road, both sides**, between its junction with Salisbury Road and its junction with East Preston Street; (iii) **Blacket Place**; (iv) **Salisbury Road**; (v) **East Newington Place**; (vi) **East Preston Street Lane**; and (vii) **Blacket Avenue**, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. Whilst this Order remains in force, ‘The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018’ is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.

6. Access for through vehicular traffic in respect to the closures will be by way of the roads outlined in Column 3 of Schedule 1 of this Order. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

SCHEDULE 1  
ROAD CLOSURES

Length of Road	Description of extent of Road Closure	Diversion routes for through vehicular traffic
Dryden Place	Between its junction with Blacket Place and its junction with Blacket Avenue	Blacket Place & Blacket Avenue
Blacket Place	Between its junction with Dalkeith Road and its junction with Blacket Avenue	Dalkeith Road & Blacket Avenue
East Newington Place	At its junction with Newington Road	No diversion available – access maintained
East Preston Street Lane	At its junction with East Preston Street	No diversion available – access maintained
Blacket Avenue	Between its junction with Dalkeith Road and its junction with Minto Street	<b>Westbound</b> – Dalkeith Road, Salisbury Road & Minto Street; & <b>Eastbound</b> – Minto Street, Newington Road, East Preston Street & Dalkeith Road
