THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (HIBERNIAN FC EASTER ROAD FIXTURES 2022/23)  
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 -  
TEMP/22/161

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -


1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Hibernian FC Easter Road Fixtures 2022/23) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022". The Order shall have effect during the hours and dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
  - (a) "Article" means an Article of this Order;  
"event related vehicles" means any vehicle constructed or adapted to carry 8 or more passengers, where said vehicle is in actual use as a private charter to drop off and/or collect supporters at Easter Road Stadium, Edinburgh;  
"Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;  
"Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order; and  
"road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road.
  - (b) References in this Order to a disabled person, to a disabled person's badge, to a disabled person's vehicle and to a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position shall be construed in accordance with the 1984 Act, The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 and The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate public safety and the safe ingress and egress of spectators during Hibernian FC Easter Road Stadium Fixtures, no person shall (as signed as affected by the event): -
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto, during the times and dates specified in the said Schedule. Closures will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise specified; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the roads specified in Schedule 2 hereto, during the times and dates specified in said Schedule, with the exception of vehicles associated with the events which are parked under Police direction. Prohibition will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise specified.
4. Nothing in the following Articles of this Order shall apply to:
  - (i) emergency service vehicles in relation to Article 3 and those roads described in Schedules 1 and 2;
  - (ii) event related vehicles in relation to Article 3(b) and that section of **Regent Road** described in Schedule 2; and
  - (iii) to a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge, provided that said vehicle is being used by, or for the conveyance of, the holder of a valid disabled person's badge in relation to Article 3(b) and those sections of **Hawkhill Avenue** (outside No. 9 only) and **St Clair Street** described in Schedule 2.
5. The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018 is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.

6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic are by way of Easter Road, London Road, Marionville Road, Lochend Road South and Lochend Road. Access for emergency vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained.

ROADS CLOSED TO THROUGH VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

**Between 14:00 hours to 15:15 hours and between 16:30 hours to 17:30 hours on:**

6<sup>th</sup> August 2022, 20<sup>th</sup> August 2022, 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2022, 17<sup>th</sup> September 2022, 8<sup>th</sup> October 2022, 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2022, 29<sup>th</sup> October 2022, 24<sup>th</sup> December 2022, 14<sup>th</sup> January 2023, 28<sup>th</sup> January 2023, 18<sup>th</sup> February 2023, 25<sup>th</sup> February 2023, 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 and 15<sup>th</sup> April 2023; and

**Between 18:45 hours to 20:00 hours and between 21:15 hours to 22:15 hours on:**

9<sup>th</sup> November 2022 and 28<sup>th</sup> December 2022 on:

(i) **Hawkhill Avenue**; (ii) **Hawkhill Close**; (iii) **St Clair Street**; (iv) **Albion Place**; (v) **Albion Road**; (vi) **Albion Terrace**; (vii) **Albion Gardens**; and (viii) **Harrismith Place**.

SCHEDULE 2  
PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING

**Between 12:00 hours and 17:30 hours on:**

6<sup>th</sup> August 2022, 20<sup>th</sup> August 2022, 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2022, 17<sup>th</sup> September 2022, 8<sup>th</sup> October 2022, 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2022, 29<sup>th</sup> October 2022, 24<sup>th</sup> December 2022, 14<sup>th</sup> January 2023, 28<sup>th</sup> January 2023, 18<sup>th</sup> February 2023, 25<sup>th</sup> February 2023, 1<sup>st</sup> April 2023 and 15<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

**Between 15:45 hours and 22:15 hours on:**

9<sup>th</sup> November 2022 and 28<sup>th</sup> December 2022 on:

(i) **Albion Road, both sides**, from its junction with Albion Place, eastwards to its junction with Lochend Butterfly Way; (ii) **Albion Place**; (iii) **Hawkhill Avenue** (*except disabled parking bay outside No. 9*); (iv) **St Clair Street, both sides** of its north/south arm (*except blue badge holders*); and (v) **Regent Road, both sides**, between its junction with Carlton Terrace Brae and its junction with Carriage Drive (*except event related vehicles*).
