THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CCWEL SECTION 1 MURRAYFIELD AVENUE AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 - TEMP/22/166

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -


1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (CCWEL Section 1 Murrayfield Avenue Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022". The Order shall have effect from the Tenth day of August Two thousand and twenty-two up to and including the Twenty-fourth day of February Two thousand and twenty-three.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
 - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
 - “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
 - "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road;
 - “Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order; and
 - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate public realm works, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works):
 - (a) drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on **Murrayfield Place**, between its junction with Murrayfield Avenue and its junction with Coltbridge Terrace;
 - (b) drive or cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed into or on any length of **Murrayfield Gardens**, between its junction with Corstorphine Road and its junction with Abinger Gardens (*except local/resident access*);
 - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on (i) **Murrayfield Avenue**: (1) ***west and south-west sides***, from the extended northern kerbline of its junction with Corstorphine Road, northwards and then north-westwards for a distance of 200 metres or thereby; and (2) ***east and north-east sides***, from the extended northern kerbline of its junction with Roseburn Terrace, northwards and then north-westwards for a distance of 200 metres or thereby; and (ii) **Corstorphine Road/Roseburn Terrace**: (1) ***north side***, from the extended eastern kerbline of Ormidale Terrace, eastwards to the extended western kerbline of Roseburn Cliff; and (2) ***south side***, from the extended eastern kerbline of Riversdale Crescent, eastwards to the extended western kerbline of Roseburn Gardens; and
 - (d) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the road described in column 1 of Schedule 1 so as to make the prohibited turn specified in column 2 of Schedule 1, into the road specified in column 3 of Schedule 1 hereto.
4. Nothing in:
 - (i) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works; or
 - (ii) Article 3(b) of this Order shall apply to local/resident access in relation to the prohibition of motor vehicles on the section of **Murrayfield Gardens**.

5. Whilst this Order continues in force, ‘The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018’ and, ‘The City of Edinburgh Council (Greenways) Order 1997’, as amended, will be suspended in so far as they are affected by the measures described in Article 3(c) of this Order.
6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic with respect to the closure of **Murrayfield Place** will be by way of: Murrayfield Avenue, Succoth Gardens, Garscube Terrace and Coltbridge Terrace.
7. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic with respect to the prohibition of motor vehicles on **Murrayfield Gardens** will be by way of: Corstorphine Road, Murrayfield Road, Murrayfield Drive and Murrayfield Gardens.
8. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic with respect to the prohibited right turns will be by way of: (i) **Roseburn Terrace** onto Murrayfield Avenue – Corstorphine Road, Ravelston Terrace, Succoth Avenue and Murrayfield Avenue; and (ii) **Murrayfield Avenue** onto Corstorphine Road – Murrayfield Avenue, Succoth Avenue, Ravelston Terrace, Murrayfield Road and Corstorphine Road.
