THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (HEART OF MIDLOTHIAN FC FIXTURES 2022/23) (NO. 2) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 - TEMP/22/175

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Heart of Midlothian FC Fixtures 2022/23) (No. 2) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022". The Order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 2. (a) In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
  - "emergency vehicles" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes; "event related vehicles" means any vehicle constructed or adapted to carry 8 or more passengers, where said vehicle is in actual use as a private charter to drop off and/or collect supporters at Tynecastle Stadium, Edinburgh;
  - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
  - "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road; and "Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order'
  - "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
  - (b) References in this Order to a disabled person, to a disabled person's badge, to a disabled person's vehicle and to a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position shall be construed in accordance with the 1984 Act, The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 and The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate public safety and the safe ingress and egress of spectators during Heart of Midlothian FC fixtures, no person shall (as signed as affected by the event): -
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto, during the hours and on the dates specified in said Schedule, where closures will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated;
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the parts of the roads during the hours and on the dates described in Schedule 2 hereto; and
  - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the roads specified in Schedule 3 hereto, during the hours and on the dates specified in said Schedule, with the exception of events vehicles which are parked under Police direction.

#### 4. Nothing in:

- (i) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles;
- (ii) Article 3(b) shall apply to a vehicle displaying a valid disabled person's badge, provided that said vehicle is being used by, or for the conveyance of, the holder of a valid disabled person's badge on the section of **Wheatfield Place** described in Schedule 2 of this Order; and
- (iii) Article 3(c) shall apply to event related vehicles on the sections of **Westfield Road** and **Russell Road** described in Schedule 3 to this Order.
- 5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(c) of this Order.
- 6. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Greenways) Traffic Regulation Order 1997', as amended, will be suspended for the duration of this Order in so far as the parking and loading bays are affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(c) of this Order.
- 7. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (CCWEL Section 1 Roseburn Street Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022 TEMP/22/152' will be suspended during the hours and on the dates specified in Schedule 1 hereto, in so far as the *one-way restriction* on **Russell Road** is affected by the closure described in Article 3(a) of this Order.
- 8. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Heart of Midlothian FC Fixtures 2022/23) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022 TEMP/22/168' is hereby revoked.
- 9. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic are by way of Roseburn Street, Westfield Road and Gorgie Road. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
