THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (MAYFIELD ROAD) (NO. 2) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 - TEMP/22/179


THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL, in exercise of powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Mayfield Road) (No. 2) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the First day of November Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirtieth day of April Two thousand and twenty-three.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
"Article" means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;  
“motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;  
and;  
"vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate a safe loading area for the adjacent construction site, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works), drive or cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven *northbound* on **Mayfield Road**, from its junction with Liberton Road, northwards for a distance of 180 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic in respect to the prohibition of motor vehicles will be by way of Liberton Road, Gordon Terrace, Esslemont Road & Mayfield Road. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
