THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (MURANO PLACE & ALBERT STREET)  
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 –  
TEMP/22/182


THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Murano Place & Albert Street) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the Thirty-first day of October Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirty-first day of December Two thousand and twenty-three.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicles” means a vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and  
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate the replacement of a collapsed sewer, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works): -
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on (i) **Murano Place**, in its entirety; and (ii) **Albert Street**, between its junction with Leith Walk and its junction with Buchanan Street;
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **Albert Street, both sides**, from a point 5 metres or thereby east of the extended eastern kerbline of Buchanan Street, westwards to its junction with Leith Walk.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in respect of the closures will be by way of
  - (i) **eastbound** – Leith Walk, London Road, Dalmeny Street, Easter Road and Albert Street; and
  - (ii) **westbound** – Albert Street, Easter Road, London Road, Dalmeny Street and Leith Walk.
