THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (ABBNEYHILL & STOCKBRIDGE AREAS)
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 –
TEMP/22/185

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Abbeyhill & Stockbridge Areas) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the Thirty-first day of October Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Twenty-fourth day of January Two thousand and twenty-three.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicles” means a vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
“Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order;
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate footway resurfacing and street lighting works, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works): -
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the sections of roads in Schedule 1 hereto, where closures will apply to the entire road unless otherwise stated; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the parts of the roads during the hours described in Schedule 2 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic in respect of the closures will be by way of (i) **Abbeyhill Area** – Rossi Place; and (ii) **Stockbridge Area** – Glenogle Road.

SCHEDULE 1
ROAD CLOSURES

Abbeyhill Area:

(i) **Regent Place**; (ii) **Lady Menzies Place**; (iii) **Waverley Place**; and (iv) **Carlyle Place**.

Stockbridge Area:

(i) **Avondale Place**; (ii) **Teviotdale Place**; (iii) **Dunrobin Place**; (iv) **Balmoral Place**; (v) **Kemp Place**; and (vi) **Bell Place**.

SCHEDULE 2
PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING

Abbeyhill Area:

(i) **Regent Place**; (ii) **Lady Menzies Place**; (iii) **Waverley Place**; (iv) **Carlyle Place**; and (v) **Rossi Place, both sides**, between its junction with Alva Place and its junction with Pitlochry Place.

Stockbridge Area:

(i) **Avondale Place**; (ii) **Teviotdale Place**; (iii) **Dunrobin Place**; (iv) **Balmoral Place**; (v) **Kemp Place**; (vi) **Bell Place**; and (vii) **Glenogle Road, north side**, between its junction with Glenogle Place and its junction with Balmoral Place.
