THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (MEADOWFIELD ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 - TEMP/22/186


THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Meadowfield Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022". The Order shall have effect from the Second day of November thousand and twenty-two up to and including the Fourteenth day of January Two thousand and twenty-three.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
"Article" means an Article of this Order;
"emergency service vehicles" means a vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;
"Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and
"vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate new sewer connection works, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works):
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on *both sides* of **Meadowfield Road**, between its junction with Turnhouse Road and its junction with Craigs Road.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in relation to the closure will be by way of Turnhouse Road and Craigs Road.
