THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CLOVENSTONE ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 - TEMP/22/187

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL, in exercise of powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Clovenstone Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the Tenth day of November Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Third day of December Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
"Article" means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means any vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes; and  
"vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate the installation of a new sewer, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works), drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on **Clovenstone Road**, between the extended south-eastern kerbline of Clovenstone Road (*east-west section*) and the extended north-eastern kerbline of Clovenstone Gardens.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic in respect to the closure will be by way of:  
(i) **northbound**: Clovenstone Road, Wester Hailes Road, Murrayburn Road and Hailesland Road; and (ii) **southbound**: Clovenstone Road, Hailesland Road, Murrayburn Road and Wester Hailes Road.
