THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (WHITEHOUSE ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 - TEMP/22/199

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Whitehouse Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022" and shall come into operation on the Seventh day of November Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Twenty-seventh day of November Two thousand and twenty-two.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order; "emergency service vehicle" means any vehicle being used for police, fire, or ambulance purposes: "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984: "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate sewer repair works, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works), except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on Whitehouse Road, east side, from the projected north gable end of No. 191 Whitehouse Road to the projected south gable end of No. 195 Whitehouse Road.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
- 5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3 of this Order.
