



THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (SYLVAN PLACE AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 – TEMP/22/194

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Sylvan Place Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the Fourteenth day of November Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Eighteenth day of December Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means any vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and  
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate installation of a new Scottish Power supply, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works): -
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the sections of roads described in Schedule 1 hereto; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the parts of the roads described in Schedule 2 hereto.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in respect of the closures will be by way of Rillbank Terrace, Millerfield Place, Melville Terrace, Livingstone Place, Sciennes Road, Tantallon Place, Hatton Place, Chalmers Crescent, Argyle Place, Fingal Place and Sylvan Place.

SCHEDULE 1  
ROAD CLOSURES

(i) **Sylvan Place**, from its junction with Fingal Place, southwards to the projected south gable end of No. 7 Sylvan Place; (ii) **Fingal Place**, from the projected west gable end of No. 7 Fingal Place, eastwards to its junction with Sylvan Place; (iii) **Rillbank Crescent**, between its junction with Sylvan Place and its junction with Rillbank Terrace; and (iv) **Rillbank Terrace**, at its junction with Rillbank Crescent.

SCHEDULE 2  
PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING

(i) **Sylvan Place, both sides**, from its junction with Fingal Place, southwards to the projected south gable end of No. 7 Sylvan Place; (ii) **Fingal Place, both sides**, from the projected west gable end of No. 7 Fingal Place, eastwards to its junction with Sylvan Place; and (iii) **Rillbank Crescent, both sides**, between its junction with Sylvan Place and its junction with Rillbank Terrace.
