THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CANAAN LANE) (NO. 2) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 – TEMP/22/197

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Canaan Lane) (No. 2) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the Twenty-first of November and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including Twenty-eighth of February Two thousand and twenty-three.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means any vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Roads (Scotland Act 1984;
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate a safe area for the construction of new flats (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall: -
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **both sides** of **Canaan Lane**, from its junction with Morningside Road to the east gable end of No. 4 Canaan Lane.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to:
 - (i) emergency service vehicles;
 - (ii) vehicles connected to the works; or
 - (iii) delivery vehicles to the Canny Man’s public house (*No. 237 Morningside Road*).
5. ‘The City of Edinburgh Council (Greenways) Order 1997’, as amended, will be suspended on **Canaan Lane** for the duration of this Order in relation to the:
 - (i) **cycle lane (eastbound)** from Morningside Road to Woodburn Terrace, to facilitate the site works area; and
 - (ii) **one-way restriction (westbound)** from Woodburn Terrace to Morningside Road, to facilitate two-way access for the movement of general traffic.
6. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.

7. Access for through vehicular traffic in respect to the closures will be way of Woodburn Terrace, Braid Avenue, Nile Grove, Hermitage Terrace and Morningside Road. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
