



THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (SNOW ZONES, VARIOUS ROADS,  
EDINBURGH) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION)  
ORDER 2022 – TEMP/22/202

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 14 (1) (a) and (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Snow Zones, Various Roads, Edinburgh) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022" and shall have effect from the Eighteenth day of November Two thousand and twenty-two up to and including the First day of May Two thousand and twenty-three.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them:  
"Article" means an Article of this Order;  
"emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for police, fire, or ambulance purposes;  
"Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;  
"vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;  
and  
"the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, when severe weather is forecast by the Met Office (as signed on site), no person shall, except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on *both sides* of the roads specified in the Schedule hereto:
  - (a) to facilitate the clearance of snow,
  - (b) to maintain traffic flow after snow has fallen on main vehicular and bus routes.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to emergency service vehicles and to any vehicle which is undertaking the statutory duties connected with this Order.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended on the affected sections of roads described the Schedule hereto.
6. The restrictions imposed by Article 3 in this Order shall repeal any existing provision, restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under Section 14 or 16 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, as amended, as aforesaid or by or under any other enactment, whilst the provisions of this Order are in operation in accordance with Article 3 of this Order.

PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING DURING PERIODS OF  
HEAVY SNOWFALL

**Balcarres Street, Calder Road, Comiston Road, Craigour Avenue, Craigour Drive,  
Dalry Road, Drum Brae Drive, Gilmerton Dykes Street, Gorgie Road (including  
Stenhouse Road, Aitkenhill, Delhaig and Chesser Cottages), Greenbank Crescent, Kirk  
Brae, Lasswade Road, Mansfield Road (Balerno), Morningside Drive, Newtoft Street and  
Oxgangs Avenue.**
