
THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (EDINBURGH'S CHRISTMAS) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 - TEMP/22/206

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of Edinburgh's Christmas event, and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under section 16B(1)(b) and 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Edinburgh's Christmas) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022". The Order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
 - "events vehicle" means any vehicle authorised by City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event;
 - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984;
 - "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road
 - "Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order;
 - "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
 - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and
 - "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate the holding of the Edinburgh's Christmas event, no person shall (as signed as affected by the event): -
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle between (i) *08:00 hours on 18/11/2022 to 22:30 hours on 16/01/2023* on **Waverley Bridge**, from its junction with Princes Street southwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby; and (ii) *09:30 hours and 22:30 hours DAILY from 25/11/2022 to 04/01/2023* on **Waverley Bridge**, from a point 40 metres south of Princes Street southwards to its junction with Market Street;
 - (b) drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on the sections of roads described during the hours and on the dates specified in Schedule 1 hereto;
 - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the parts of the roads during the hours and on the dates specified in Schedule 2 hereto;
 - (d) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the parts of the roads during the hours and on the dates specified in Schedule 3 hereto; and
 - (e) on foot, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, enter or proceed along or use in any other manner whatsoever any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4.

4. Nothing in:
 - (i) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles;
 - (ii) Article 3(b) shall apply to events vehicles on the section of King's Stables Road described in Schedule 1, during the hours specified in the said Schedule;
 - (iii) Article 3(c) shall apply to vehicles loading during the hours specified in Schedule 2;
 - (iv) Article 3(d) shall apply to events vehicles on the sections of King's Stables Road and Regent Road described in Schedule 3, during the hours specified in the said Schedule;
 - (v) Article 3(e) shall apply to persons who:
 - (a) are an authorised person carrying out work directly in relation of the Edinburgh's Christmas or National Galleries of Scotland sites; or
 - (b) are, or are acting on the authority of, a police constable in uniform; or
 - (c) are engaged in dealing with an emergency which requires that person to use the relevant road.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Articles 3(c) and (d) of this Order.
6. "The City of Edinburgh Council (Edinburgh Tram) (Prohibition of Entry, Motor Vehicles and Turning, One-Way Roads, Bus/Tram Priority Lanes and Weight Limit) Traffic Regulation Order 2010" will be suspended **from 08:00 hours on 18/11/2022 to 23:59 hours on 25/11/2022 and from 08:00 hours on 04/01/2023 to 23:59 hours on 16/01/2023** in relation to **trams, buses, taxis & cycles only** on **Princes Street**, between its junction with South St David Street and its junction with Frederick Street, to allow event related vehicles to access and egress from The Mound precinct.
7. "The City of Edinburgh Council (Waverley Bridge Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022" will be suspended **from 08:00 hours on 18/11/2022 to 23:59 hours 16/01/2023** in relation to **road closure and prohibition of waiting, loading and unloading** on **Waverley Bridge**, to allow closure of the whole road and facilitate the build, management, operation and derig of elements of Edinburgh's Christmas event.
8. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic will be by way of: Castle Terrace, Spittal Street, Lady Lawson Street, West Port, North Charlotte Street, Queen Street, North Castle Street and Frederick Street. Pedestrian access will be maintained, except the section described in Article 3(e).

SCHEDULE 1
PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

From 08:00 hours on 18/11/2022 to 23:59 hours on 28/11/2022 and from 08:00 hours on 19/12/2022 to 23:59 hours on 15/01/2023 on:

King's Stables Road, from the north-westernmost extent of the entrance to the NCP car park, north-westwards to its junction with Lothian Road (*except events vehicles*)

From 08:00 hours on 18/11/2022 to 23:59 hours on 13/01/2023:

George Street, between its junction with Charlotte Square and its junction with Castle Street; (*except vehicles accessing eastbound for loading between 06:30 hours to 09:30 hours DAILY*).

SCHEDULE 2
RESTRICTIONS ON WAITING

From 00:01 hours on 18/11/2022 to 23:59 hours on 13/01/2023:

George Street, both sides, between its junction with Charlotte Square and its junction with Castle Street (*except loading in designated bays between 06:30 hours and 09:30 hours DAILY*).

From 08:00 hours on 18/11/2022 to 23:59 hours on 16/01/2023:

Waverley Bridge, (i) *east side*, from its junction with Princes Street southwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby; and (ii) *west side*, from its junction with Princes Street southwards for a distance of 90 metres or thereby (*except events vehicles between 22:30 hours and 09:30 hours DAILY*).

From 10:00 hours on 25/11/2022 to 22:30 hours on 04/01/2023:

Waverley Bridge, (i) *west side*, from its junction with Market Street northwards to a point 90 metres south of Princes Street; and (ii) *east side*, in its entirety (*except loading between 22:30 hours and 09:30 hours DAILY*).

SCHEDULE 3
PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING & UNLOADING

From 08:00 hours on 18/11/2022 to 23:59 hours on 28/11/2022 and from 08:00 hours on 19/12/2022 to 23:59 hours on 16/01/2023:

(i) **King's Stables Road, both sides**, from the north-westernmost extent of the vehicular entrance to the NCP car park, north-westwards to its junction with Lothian Road (*except events vehicles*); and (ii) **Regent Road, south side**, from the Burns Monument entrance gate eastwards for a distance of 20 metres or thereby and westwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby (*except events vehicles*).

From 00:01 hours on 18/11/2022 to 23:59 hours on 25/11/2022 and from 00:01 hours on 04/01/2023 to 23:59 hours on 15/01/2023:

Market Street, north side, in its entirety (*excluding the bus stop*).

From 00:01 hours on 26/11/2022 to 23:59 hours on 03/01/2023:

Market Street, north side, from a point 70 metres west of its junction with Waverley Bridge westwards for 22 metres or thereby;

SCHEDULE 4
PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS

From 22:30 hours to 09:30 hours DAILY between 18/11/2022 and 16/01/2023:

The Mound Precinct, from a point south of the access onto the top path of East Princes Street Gardens, south-westwards to the west gable end of the National Gallery Buildings.
