THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (BANKHEAD PLACE) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022 – TEMP/22/193

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Bankhead Place) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2022” and shall come into operation on the Twenty-eighth day of November Two thousand and twenty-two and shall remain in force up to and including the Nineteenth day of December Two thousand and twenty-two.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicles” means a vehicle being used for police, fire or ambulance purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate the installation of new drainage pipes, no person shall (as signed as affected by the works): -
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on **Bankhead Place**, between its junction with Bankhead Crossway South and its junction with Bankhead Loan;
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **Bankhead Place, both sides**, from a point 5 metres or thereby south of its junction with Bankhead Loan, northwards to a point 5 metres or thereby north of its junction with Bankhead Crossway South.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles connected to the works.
5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic in respect of the closures will be by way of (i) **eastbound** – Bankhead Loan, Bankhead Avenue and Bankhead Crossway South; and (ii) **westbound** – Bankhead Place, Calder Road (*service road*), Bankhead Drive and Bankhead Crossway South.
